Ticket prices are still ₱500 for Adults and students grade 6 and above. ₱250 for student grade 5 and below. Kids 2 years and under come free! Remember they cost more at the gate on the day of the event (₱700 for Adults and ₱400 for Children)

Driver's meal tickets are also available at ₱100 entitling them to a meal at the lower level staff canteen. It does not entitle them to Food Fest entrance.

Feel free to purchase a regular adult ticket (P500) for any companions you wish to join you at Food Fest.

Please note that all students, parents, teachers, school administrators and staff coming to the Food fest are required to purchase a ticket. Juniors who do a lot of the work at Food fest will all buy tickets as well. Every year, a large percentage of Brent families participate in helping at country tables, whether cooking or preparing food, or serving on the day, and they all buy their tickets. So we make no exceptions. We thank you all so much for your support. Food fest is our way of supporting the various school clubs for our Brent kids as well as the Juniors.

We often have helpers that want to enter without a ticket. We will have Juniors available to help people carry food and decorations to food booths so helpers do NOT need to come in. If families want helpers to watch children, they MUST purchase a ticket for them as well.
